

School Admissions Appeals Code

The Cherwell School Academy Trust follows the Admissions process of the Oxfordshire Local Authority co-ordinated scheme.

Parents and carers who wish to appeal against the decision of the Trustees/Governors of The Cherwell School Academy Trust to refuse to offer their child a place in the school may make an appeal to an Independent Panel, and details of the procedure are available from the Oxfordshire County Council (OCC) website: www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/schoolappeals

The Independent Panel hearing the appeal have a statutory duty to act in accordance with:-

- The School Standards and Framework Act (SSFA) 1998, as amended by subsequent legislation and case law;
- The Codes on School Admissions and School Admission Appeals produced by the Department for Education (DfE);

Both of which govern all school admission appeals/reviews.

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
