A variety of clubs are run for Cherwell students each term, these are run or assisted by staff, interns, visitors and pupils. The clubs happen on both sites and are either age specific or open to anyone. All details about clubs are advertised in assemblies, bulletins, registers and published termly on the website. Clubs happen during lunch hours or after school as appropriate. Clubs are sometimes seasonal and only run during particular terms, others run all year. During examination periods, there are revision sessions run as clubs, for pupils in a whole variety of subjects, these are advertised via registers as they are normally year groups specific.

As part of the Cherwell Competencies, all pupils are encouraged to join clubs to enhance their school life. Clubs are fully inclusive, within the specified age groupings.
